SAO TI is an independant French artist, singer songwriter and co-composer from the south of France.

She developed her passion for music very early and was very inspired by different music genres. Indeed, this brings to her a rich musical culture from all over the world. She sings in French, Arabic, English, Spanish and Portuguese and also has been influenced by many different styles such as Rnb, Soul, Jazz, Hip Hop and World Music.

She released in July 2018 her first single in French entitled "*Relativiser*" with a music video that she directed. "*Be Great*", her second single with a very personal message behind, was released on March 8th 2019 (this is the Women's Day in France), a way for her to express her deep desire as a woman to always aim for the best.

In december of this same year, she has realeased "*Should I*". In this song, Sao Ti came back to one of her very first love, Rnb. She said that RnB and Soul Music are her greatest influences in her music. In fact, her love for these styles is so evident and clear during her concerts, singing originals but also covers songs of artists like Etta James, Amy Winehouse, Beyonce, Tamia, Stevie Wonder and many others.

The last song is "*Try To Forget Me*" which Sao Ti mixed with her frequent collaborator Silasse, has been released during the summer of 2020. She directed the music video, marking the second time she's done so for an official single's music video after "*Relativiser*".

We discover in this music video a very elegant and feminine Asian cinematographic setting. Indeed a quite relevant and interesting contrast with the rhythm of the song that is actually more in a Hip Hop Style. This was perceived as a nod to the Asian origins, attributed to her, by her audience.

Sao Ti is working now on her first EP that will be released in 2021.
